

Georgetown Visitation - Class of 2010 Senior Yearbook Portrait Sessions

Dear Senior:

Enclosed is an appointment for your senior portrait session which will provide a photograph for the Class of 2010 Visitation Yearbook. All seniors must be photographed at our Bethesda studio during June and July to ensure that their photo appears in the yearbook. (The senior section of the yearbook is the first to go to press in the fall.) You will select your favorite pose from the 10-12 "headshot" poses from your session. We will then perform retouching, color correction and cropping and submit it to your school.

For a more extensive portrait experience, choose one of our two optional sessions which offer a variety of poses and clothing changes to showcase your personality and style at this special time in your life. Should you choose one of the optional sittings, we will have to reschedule your appointment to allow more time for the additional poses.

We offer a wide variety of portrait sizes, finishes, products and frames to suit your needs. Examples are on the back of this letter.

PICK UP THE PHONE

- If you cannot make this time, **PLEASE CALL IMMEDIATELY** and reschedule for a more convenient time.
- Yearbook photos must be taken in June & July. We have evening and limited weekend slots available.
- A \$10 "no-show" charge is applied for less than 2 days notice of cancellation.
- If you plan to be away for the summer, get it done before you go. Once school starts, it will be very difficult to get an appointment and you'll be way too busy.
- You **MUST** reschedule if you choose the Deluxe or Extended photo session.

PICK A SESSION

Choose from one of these 3 sessions, with some sample poses shown below.

YEARBOOK SESSION

10-12 headshot poses that conform to your school yearbook requirements.

DELUXE SESSION

Headshot yearbook poses PLUS casual poses. These poses will be more relaxed and personal. Poses may show from knees up, so dress head-to-toe for continuity. One additional clothing change.

45 minutes

EXTENDED SESSION

Headshot yearbook poses PLUS multiple casual poses. These poses will be more expressive and may include full-length poses, background changes, outdoor settings, musical instruments, props or even friends, siblings or pets. Dress head-to-toe. Two additional clothing changes.

- ◆ Be informed and plan your session carefully, additional charges apply for retakes.

CHECK YOUR CLOSET

- ◆ Best clothing choices for the yearbook headshot pose are dark solid colored tops with a modest neckline and long-sleeves. These are flattering for everyone and have a slimming effect. Do not wear patterns or stripes.
- ◆ **DO NOT WEAR A SLEEVELESS TOP** - your photo will be cropped for publication, and large areas of exposed skin will be chopped into strange chunky shapes which will distract from your lovely face - which is the focus.
- ◆ Accent your look with jewelry.

CHECK THE MIRROR

- ◆ Wear heavier make-up than normal, especially mascara.
- ◆ Avoid shine by using a light powder or blotting before picture time.
- ◆ Hair should be flattering to your face, not pulled back - avoid trendy or unusual styles.
- ◆ Don't be sunburned or show obvious tanlines - these are expensive to correct.
- ◆ Don't worry about zits - basic skin retouching is included for yearbook and purchased photos.
- ◆ Wear clothes that fit well - bulging, puckering, or gapping will be accentuated.

GET READY

- ◆ Confirm your appointment, we'll also be calling to remind you.
- ◆ Check a map or our website for directions - know where you are going - leave plenty of time.
- ◆ Be sure to have your Sitting Fee with you (cash, ck, MC/VISA).
- ◆ **BE SURE YOU ARE NOT WEARING A SLEEVELESS TOP.**

GET SET

- ◆ Be on time! Your session may be cut short or have to be rescheduled if you are late or wearing a sleeveless top.
- ◆ Be ready to be photographed at the appointed time - be early if you need to check hair, make-up and clothing.
- ◆ Additional charges apply for digital hair and clothing corrections.

GET IT DONE

- ◆ Be On Time! - you'll be more relaxed.
- ◆ Our photographers are experienced professionals who will be sure to capture your best.
